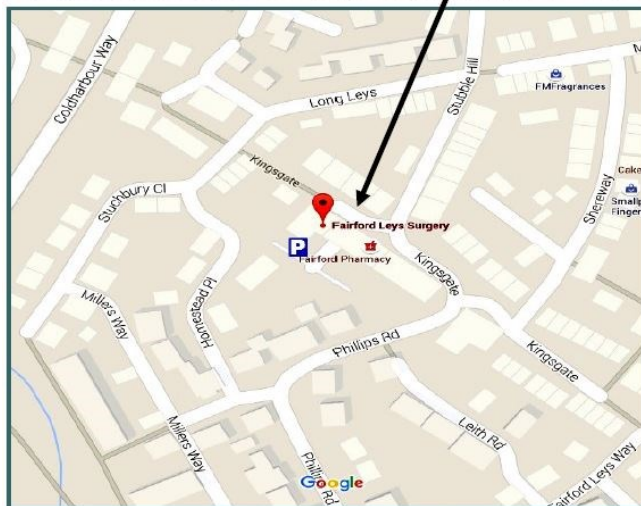


## Where is the clinic?

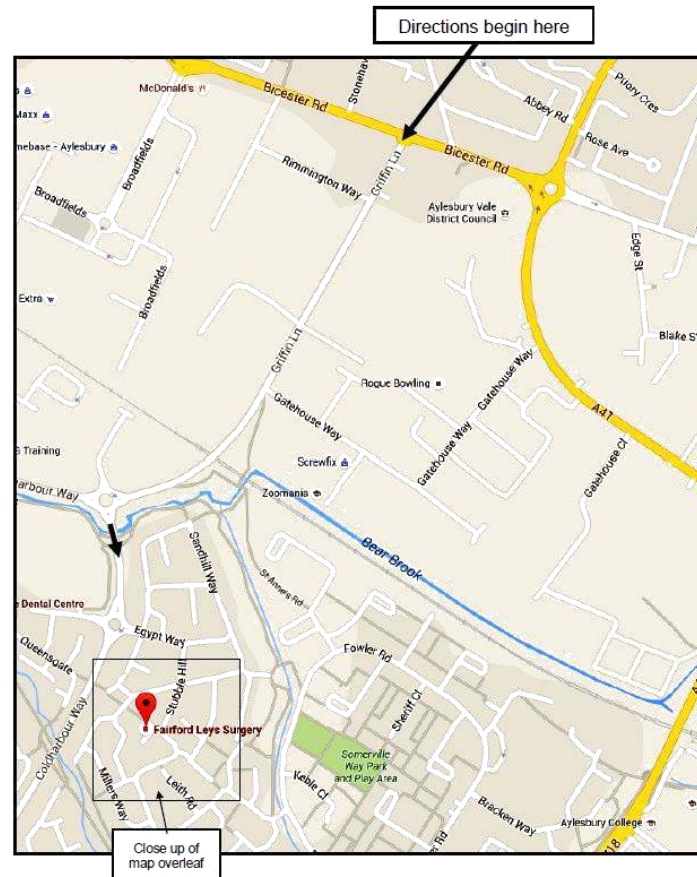
You should use the main entrance (building right of pharmacy in photo) and report to main reception.

## Directions

From **Bicester Road (A41)**

- At the roundabout, take the exit onto **Griffin Lane** (signposted Fairford Leys)
- At the roundabout, take the **1st** exit onto **Coldharbour Way**
- At the roundabout, take the **1st** exit onto **Egypt Way**
- Road bends to **right** - **Stubble Hill**, continue onto **Kingsgate Rd**- the surgery will be visible.

## What is the Intermediate Gynaecology Service?

This is a community based service run by FedBucks in partnership with the NHS.

FedBucks is a federation of GP practices covering a patient population of over 485,000 patients across Buckinghamshire. They provide local GP representation through their Board of Directors and regularly meet with practice members and with other key stakeholders including the second north Bucks GP federation, Medicas.

FedBucks also works in collaboration with the other three main Buckinghamshire healthcare providers, Buckinghamshire Healthcare Trust, South Central Ambulance Service and Oxford Health Foundation Trust through a Memorandum of Understanding.

We will make sure that you are seen by the right person for the assessment and treatment of your problem.

## How the Service works

You have been referred by your GP to a local, specialist gynaecology clinic. Your referral will be assessed quickly and we will contact you to let you know the details of your appointment at our clinic.

## About your appointment

Our Intermediate Gynaecology Clinic is based at The Fairford Leys Surgery. You will receive a letter from us giving you a date and time for attendance.

The address of the surgery together with location maps can be found on the reverse of this leaflet.

It is important that you attend your appointment as arranged.
