## What is the Community ENT Service?

This is a well established service that is run by FedBucks in partnership with Millbarn Medical Centre in Beaconsfield.

The service sees people with a range of non-urgent ENT problems. (ENT means Ear, Nose and Throat.)

## Aims

The aim of the Community ENT service is to assess and treat a range of non-urgent problems to avoid unnecessary referral into hospital.

A specialist GP will diagnose your problem and will then either provide advice back to your GP, or arrange any appropriate investigations and provide treatment if necessary.

## How the Service works

You have been referred by your GP to the Community ENT service. You will need to contact Millbarn Medical Centre to make an appointment on a day and time that is convenient to you. Please wait 5 days from seeing your GP.

Appointments can usually be offered within three to four weeks of receipt of referral.

A range of appointments are available during the week, from early morning to early evening.

You will be asked to attend the ENT clinic at Millbarn Medical Centre on the day of your appointment.

The address and a map showing the location of the clinic are provided on the back of this leaflet.

## Reasons for referral

The most common reasons for referral to this service are:

- Microsuction to remove ear wax
- Removal of foreign bodies from the ear
- Assessment of tinnitus
- Hearing assessment
- Recurring dizziness and vertigo
- Prevention of nose bleeds
